However, as directors, it is our task to determine the most appropriate role for every actor - for their individual success and the ultimate good of the show. It is a daunting task, with many factors playing a part in the final decision. Yet, we pride ourselves in fostering an attitude of mutual respect, where all actors work hard as a team and are always kind to each other. Without a cooperative spirit and shared sense of pride in the final outcome, a truly successful production would never be possible.

- **CASTING** – It is understood that role assignments are the final decision of the directors, always in the best interest of the show and *non-negotiable*. It is expected that performers accept their assignments with *grace and professionalism*. Any negative attitudes that prove counterproductive to the production may result in an actor's removal from the show (with no refund) and possibly no further participation in SGP programs.
- **ATTENDANCE** - **Please review the class dates CAREFULLY.** Due to the limited rehearsal time in a nine-week program, no rehearsals can be missed. Misses may result in role replacement. Please be prompt in dropping off and picking up performers from class.
